This is a domestic disturbance; the victim and the defendant are former intimate partners.

On 2/23/2019 at 1007 Officers were dispatched to Night Court in relation to an alleged domestic disturbance. Upon arrival, Officers spoke with the Victim [REDACTED] who made multiple statements to Officers regarding incidents involving the Defendant/Crutcher.

The Victim stated that the Defendant made a threat to her via a text message, sent from the Defendant's phone to the Victim's phone, on 18 February 2019 at approximately 0242. She stated that the Defendant said "Hoe, I will kill you." She stated that this message scared her. The Victim showed Officers a text message she claimed was from the Defendant; the message stated "Hoe, I will kill you".
